# Program Options

## PreK-K program

Available to children 4-6 years old. This program follows a modified schedule to incorporate the needs of younger children throughout the day. Children learn through a variety of engaging activities around a central theme.



Summer Sage offers a half-day option at a reduced cost. This program runs from 9:00 a.m. until 12:15 p.m. to include an enrichment period, creative activities, and lunch.

# School Age Program

Available to children 7-11 years old. This program is focused on weekly enrichment themes based on educational disciplines along with traditional day camp activities. Participants will have the opportunity to choose a focus area within each weekly theme.
