Staff

Program Options

Each week of Summer Sage has an exciting academic enrichment theme selected to stimulate curiosity and encourage a love of learning.

The School Age program is available to children entering first grade through age 10. This program provides in-depth exploration of a central theme through educational disciplines along with traditional day camp activities.

The PreK-K program is available to children ages 4-6 and offers a modified schedule to incorporate the needs of younger children throughout the day. Children learn through a variety of engaging activities focused around a central theme.

Children will be placed in either the PreK-K program or School Age program based on their level in school.

Through observation, nature journals, species identification, literature, and more fun activities we will learn about the natural world and how we are connected to it. Through literature, geography, math, and more, we will explore different aspects of culture and design. Who knows what amazing communities we will create!
